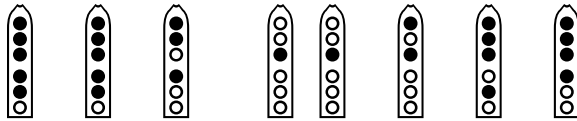

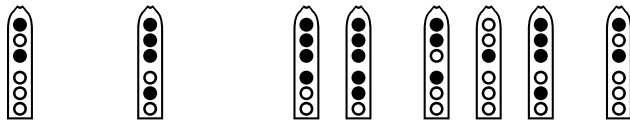
Ukulele chords in blue.

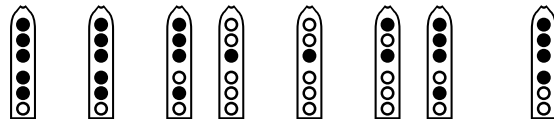

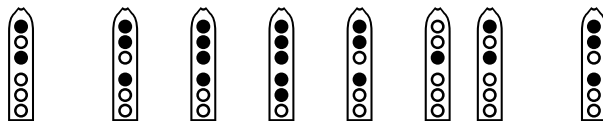
